This four-day institute offers teachers, school administrators, and community members an opportunity to become familiar with the possibilities, principles, and practices of place-based education. This approach to teaching and learning focuses on local culture, history, natural resource issues, economics, and community processes as the basis for a proportion of students' educational experiences. Teaching in this way benefits both students and their communities. Students encounter learning opportunities that are personally engaging and valued by others. And communities gain from the imagination, energy, and commitment of their youngest citizens.

The institute includes:

- Presentations from educators experienced in place-based approaches
- An exploration of ways to link place-based units to academic standards
- Opportunities to try out place-based educational practices
- Visits to community partners willing to help integrate place-based education into the classroom
- Time for feedback on a locally focused unit for classroom use
